Restorative Justice Peacemaking Circles hold potential for any community to provide support and healing for Veterans and their loved ones. Peacemaking Circle process engages diverse parties in reaffirming, repairing and rebuilding relationships. This training on Peacemaking Circles will focus specifically on working with Veterans. Emphasis will include a focus on the roles of Veteran peers, Veteran supporters and non-Veteran community mentors. Restorative Justice approaches have been effective in reintegration, healing and transforming behavior.
